

A Tradition of Excellence in Athletics

Greeneville High School from the beginning has demonstrated an excellence in sports. With a great fan base and pride in how they perform, GHS has continued a great tradition throughout the years.

Greeneville High School won several Conference, District, Regional, and Sub-state Championships and presented the community with two undefeated teams: the 1942 Football team was 8-0 and rated as high as 8th in state rankings; the 1936-37 Girl's Basketball team was 18-0 in regular season, 4-0 in district play, and 4-0 in regional play in Knoxville, defeating Bradley Central 49-44 in the finals. Three regional champions were crowned at that time without a playoff to determine a state champion.

Greeneville High School has several individual state champions: Stephen Shao - 2004 Boys Tennis Singles; Daniel Crosby - 2002 & 2003 Wrestling 275 Wt. Class; Jeremy Garrett - 2000 Wrestling 135 Wt. Class; Jeremy Anderson - 1999 Boys High Jump; Jason Riddle - 1999 Wrestling 215 Wt. Class; Brandon Lowery - 1997 Wrestling 119 Wt. Class; Josh Barner - 1997 Wrestling 189 Wt. Class; Dustin Moore - 1994 Boys 200 Meter Dash & 1993 Mr. Football; Brigham Lyons - 1991 Boys 300 Meter Low Hurdles; Karen Socha - 1983 (spring), 1983 (fall), 1984 & 1985 Girls Golf; Rita Story - 1980 Girls Pentathlon; and Joel Brimer - 2008 Wrestling 160 Wt. Class

The 1983 Boys Golf Team provided GHS with its only state team championship.

Many athletes went on to excel in college with several attaining all conference and all American status. Many have been inducted into their college hall of fame and some have had successful careers at the professional level.

Greeneville High School Hall of Fame

Eligibility Requirements

The Greeneville High School Sports Hall of Fame Committee is an organization established to honor outstanding sports figures. Each year the Committee will select new members to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. The public is invited to submit names of candidates for consideration.

Those elected to the Greeneville High School Sports Hall of Fame will be honored and their picture will be added to the GHS Hall of Fame.

The established criterion for selection to the Hall of Fame is:

- Good moral character
- Must have made an outstanding contribution in the field of athletics, whether it be as a participant, coach, promoter, organizer or a person otherwise involved.
- Notoriety or success of the athlete must have been accomplished primarily at Greeneville High School with a degree of consideration given to accomplishments afterward. In the case of the non-athlete considered, his/her deeds must be on behalf of the Greeneville High School Sports Program.
- In the case of the athlete, he/she must have been graduated from Greeneville High School at least 10 years.
- Does not have to be a Greeneville or Greene County resident at the time of nomination.
- May be nominated and elected posthumously.
